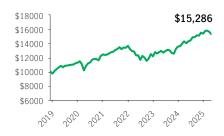

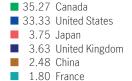

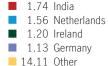


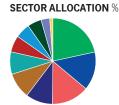
**ASSET ALLOCATION** %
